

## How Ben helped Hugh when he was homeless

Hugh became homeless after his relationship broke down. He has four children, one of whom has autism.




When Hugh contacted Ben, he was sleeping at his place of work whilst waiting for the local housing authority to find him accommodation. He had received offers for one bedroom flats, but these weren't suitable as his son, who has autism, needs his own space.

Ben helped Hugh put together a budget and then assisted him in searching for suitable accommodation within his price range. Additionally, Ben offered to help him find local furniture packages.

Hugh was also worried that he had no-one to talk to about parenting, so Ben put him in touch with local services who support single dads.

Following help from Ben, Hugh found a rental property to move into and was able to buy furniture for it. Additionally, his local support group have given him a much-needed confidence boost.
