Ben gave Mervyn peace of mind

Mervyn, an 83 year-old former panel beater, struggles with mobility and personal care and he is also showing early signs of dementia. His wife died several years ago, but his son lives nearby and his daughter visits to help when she can.



Ben has helped Mervyn by working with him and his son to ensure that his local occupational therapy service provided him with the bathing aids he needed. Ben also ensured that Mervyn now has a personal home care service helping him to stay independent.

Mervyn was also concerned about security as a number of key safes

in his local area had been broken into in order to gain access to the properties. Therefore, Ben offered Mervyn financial help and provided a secure barrel lock with safe keys that can't be copied. This means that Mervyn's carers and his family can visit whenever they need to and Mervyn now has peace of mind about security.
